

It's time to restore freedom, choice, and accountability to Montana's elections.

CI-126 and CI-127 are simple, common-sense solutions by Montanans, for Montanans.

How do they work?

CI-126 and CI-127 are two constitutional citizen initiatives that will open Montana's primaries and require candidates to win a majority of votes in November. Instead of being forced to choose one party's ballot when we vote in the primary, and therefore choosing from only a partial list of qualified candidates, voters will have the **freedom** to choose from all qualified candidates, regardless of party affiliation. All voters receive the same ballot and choose from the same list of qualified candidates. The majority-winner initiative then ensures that a majority of voters support the winning candidate in November, putting power back into the hands of voters.

Why do we need CI-126 & CI-127?

Open primaries and majority-winner elections are proven solutions to our broken politics. Both reforms reduce the power of political parties and special interests and require candidates to appeal to a broad base of voters, holding elected officials accountable to their constituents.

CI-126 and CI-127 are a critical step toward reducing partisan division and restoring freedom, choice, and accountability to our politics.
